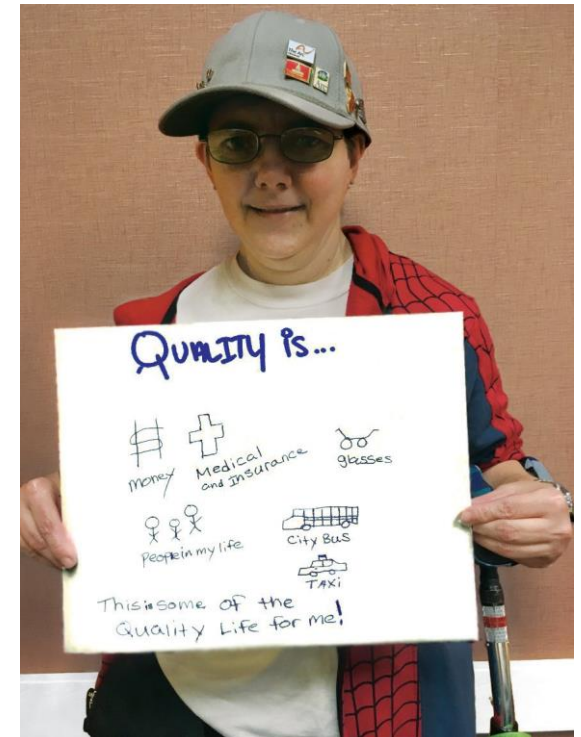

Primary Goals



- Improve services and supports for people with disabilities through quality improvement projects.
- Review and evaluate informed-decision making processes.
- Promote person-centered thinking and practices.
- Create system-wide change by sharing best practices and resources.
- Report to the Department of Human Services and regional stakeholders with findings and recommendations to improve quality of services.

Improving Quality

The Regional Quality Councils work to improve the quality of life for people with disabilities in their regions.

They do this in many ways:

- Connect with the community through listening sessions, focus groups and informational interviews.
- Collaborate with community partners to include all voices in the disabilities community.
- Gather and review data on the quality of services and supports for people with disabilities.
- Track and monitor different systems that shape the quality of life for people with disabilities.
- Create and share resources for different audiences.
- Attend conferences and trainings to learn new ways of improving the quality of services and supports for people with disabilities.

The Arc



In July 2016, with advice from the State Quality Council, The Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) issued grants to form three regional quality councils.

The Arc Minnesota Greater Twin Cities is the host of the Metro Regional Quality Council, which includes Dakota, Hennepin, and Scott counties.

The Arc Northland is the host of the Arrowhead Regional Quality Council, which includes Carlton, Cook, Lake, and St. Louis counties.

The Arc Minnesota Southeast Region is the host of the Region 10 Regional Quality Council, which includes Houston, Olmsted, and Wabasha counties.
